LOT 111A *Should read* A cased preserved duck, 49cm x 48cm and a cased preserved pair of guillemots and one other cased wildfowl in a naturalistic setting (3).

\* *Provenance Puslinch.*

LOT 113 *Should read* A cased display of preserved British birds, to include a woodpecker, jay etc, in a naturalistic setting, 49cm x 52cm and two other smaller cases of preserved birds.

LOT 116 *Should read* A late 19th Century cased preserved crested Grebe, label to back of case 'Wm Drew Naturalist, 12 Union Street, Stonehouse', 42cm x 40cm and one other cased preserved sea bird.

\* *Provenance Puslinch.*

LOT 172A *Should read* A 19th Century double barrel side by side percussion cap sporting gun the scroll engraved hares ears hammers over scroll engraved side lock with dog and pheasant scene, double trigger and scroll chased trigger guard on a chequered walnut stock.

LOT 193 *Should read* A WWII Royal Devon Yeomanry Artillery, officers tunic with hand engraved brass buttons and sam brown belt.

LOT 296 *Should read* Continental School (19th Century) "Portrait of an 18th Century Hunter, standing with his gun and dog in a landscape" also a companion, the pair, oils on canvas board, 29cm x 17cm (2).
